Hartfield Parish Council - Environment and Transport Committee

Terms of reference

Role

The Environment and Transport Committee is responsible for preserving and enhancing our natural environment and minimising the adverse impact of transport upon it and the Parish.

Membership

A minimum of 4 members, all of whom must be Parish Councillors and one of whom will be elected Chairman, and one as Vice Chairman. Further members may be coopted subject to the approval of the Parish Council.

<u>Note</u>: the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Parish Council are ex-officio members of the Environment and Transport Committee.

Co-ordination

Co-ordination will be undertaken by the Chairman of the Committee, who will also ensure accurate minutes of the meeting are taken and kept.

Frequency of meetings

The Environment and Transport Committee will meet bi-annually.

Quorum

The quorum of the Committee shall be 3 Parish Councillors

Responsibilities

To include, but not limited to:

- Climate change
- Highways
- Ashdown Forest
- Landscape issues
- Tourism
- Recycling and waste
- · Conservation of flora and fauna
- Pollution air, water, drains etc
- Appearance of parish including dog fouling and littering
- Traffic management, speed etc
- Transport
- Rivers, flooding and ordinary water courses.

Reporting arrangements

The minutes of each Committee meeting will be distributed promptly to all members of the Parish Council via the Clerk and posted on the Parish Council web-site. Items falling outside the terms of reference should be referred to the appropriate committee or the full Parish Council.
