- Each topic area represented on steering committee
- All meetings open to the public
- Regular communication
- Simple constitution (models available)
- Maintain accounts
- Try to engage everyone (e.g. all ages)

The Action Plan Process

Initial work

- Setting the foundations
- Creating the steering group
 - Starting the process and keeping it rolling.
- Plan the consultation
 - Involve everyone, not just the 'usual suspects'
- Consider the costs involved
 - obtain funding
- Community voices:
 - Gathering consultation responses and analysing data

- Bringing things together
 - Create your draft Action Plan
- Pulling the plan together
 - Developing the final action plan
- New directions and concrete actions
 - Obtaining project funding, training and working in partnership
- Build on your successes
 - Monitor, evaluate and review
 - look forward
